With 70 beds, Stony Brook Eastern Long Island Hospital (SBELIH) is an acute care community hospital committed to delivering excellence in patient care and meeting the current and emerging health needs of the North Fork and Shelter Island. In 2019, Eastern Long Island Hospital joined with Stony Brook Medicine to preserve the mission of our founders to better serve our community. A campus of Stony Brook University Hospital, SBELIH provides regional behavioral health programs serving the greater Suffolk County area.

At SBELIH, inpatients are under the care of world-renowned hospitalists, physicians who specialize in inpatient medicine and taking care of hospitalized patients in place of a primary care provider. Centers of Excellence include Medical-Surgical, Advanced Ambulatory Care, Behavioral Health, Emergency, Geriatric, Diagnostic Services, Physical Therapy and Gastrointestinal Services. SBELIH is fully accredited by the Joint Commission on Accreditation of Healthcare Organizations and has been awarded the Gold Seal of Approval.

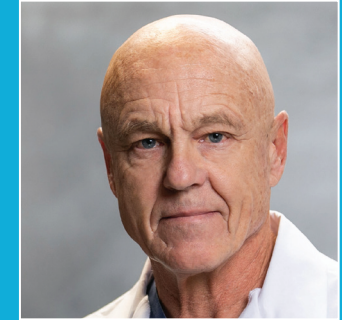

For 118 years, this hospital has stood as a vital part of the community. We provide healthcare to the North Fork and Shelter Island. We are the largest employer in the area, providing more than 420 jobs, and have an impact of \$25 million to the local economy every year.

For more than 118 years, the ELIH Auxiliary has dedicated itself to ensuring that the residents and visitors of the North Fork and Shelter Island have ready access to the highest quality healthcare.

In 2022, our all-volunteer group of 110 passionate community members provided close to 14,000 hours of service with in-hospital volunteers providing 814 hours of service, the Opportunity Shop volunteers providing 8,987 hours of service, and the balance of hours of service provided by our wonderful Auxiliary Executive Board, through special fundraising projects undertaken by the Membership/Special Projects Division such as Ladies Day on the Links and the Italian Night Dinner and two annual Auxiliary fundraisers-the Dream Green Extravaganza and the Car/Cash Giveaway.

Our motivation today remains the same, to ensure that our local community hospital, Stony Brook Eastern Island Hospital, continues to thrive and has the resources needed to add innovative technologies and care programs.

I am proud to say that 2022 was another banner fundraising year for the ELIH Auxiliary. Much of last year's success is due to the hard-working volunteers at the ELIH Opportunity Shop, a thrift shop in Greenport Village. Through their efforts, as well as Membership/Special Events projects and two major fundraising events, we donated \$555,000 to the Hospital!

The total donations from the Auxiliary to the ELIH Foundation were \$360,500 in unrestricted gifts, \$40,000 from the Car/Cash Giveaway, \$116,000 from the Dream Green Extravaganza, \$30,500 designated for a new ICU Ventilator and \$8,000 designated for our wonderful Employees' holiday party. In addition to the \$555,000, \$700 in Memorial donations were made to honor Auxilians, and, effective June 2022 the Auxiliary assumed 100% of the cost to provide in-Hospital cable TV service to our patients. Over the years, the Auxiliary has raised close to \$12 million for our Hospital.

I am grateful to the many talented volunteers and members who generously give their time to the ELIH Auxiliary. Your talent, ingenuity, and dedication inspire me every day!

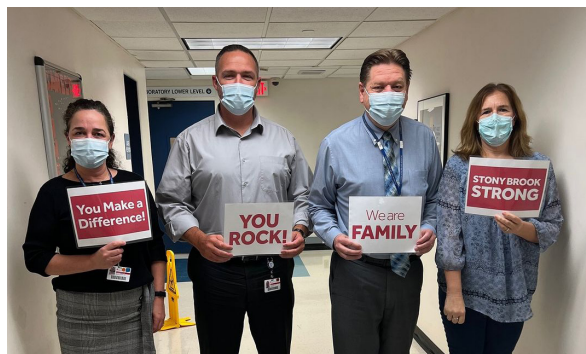

Due to less invasive procedures and quicker healing times, about 85% of our surgeries are performed in the Advanced Ambulatory Care Center. Ambulatory surgery patients are educated prior to their scheduled surgery to ensure that they fully understand the procedure, ensuring both patient and family have all their questions answered to their satisfaction.

Our goal is to provide streamlined patient care in a beautifully designed contemporary environment. 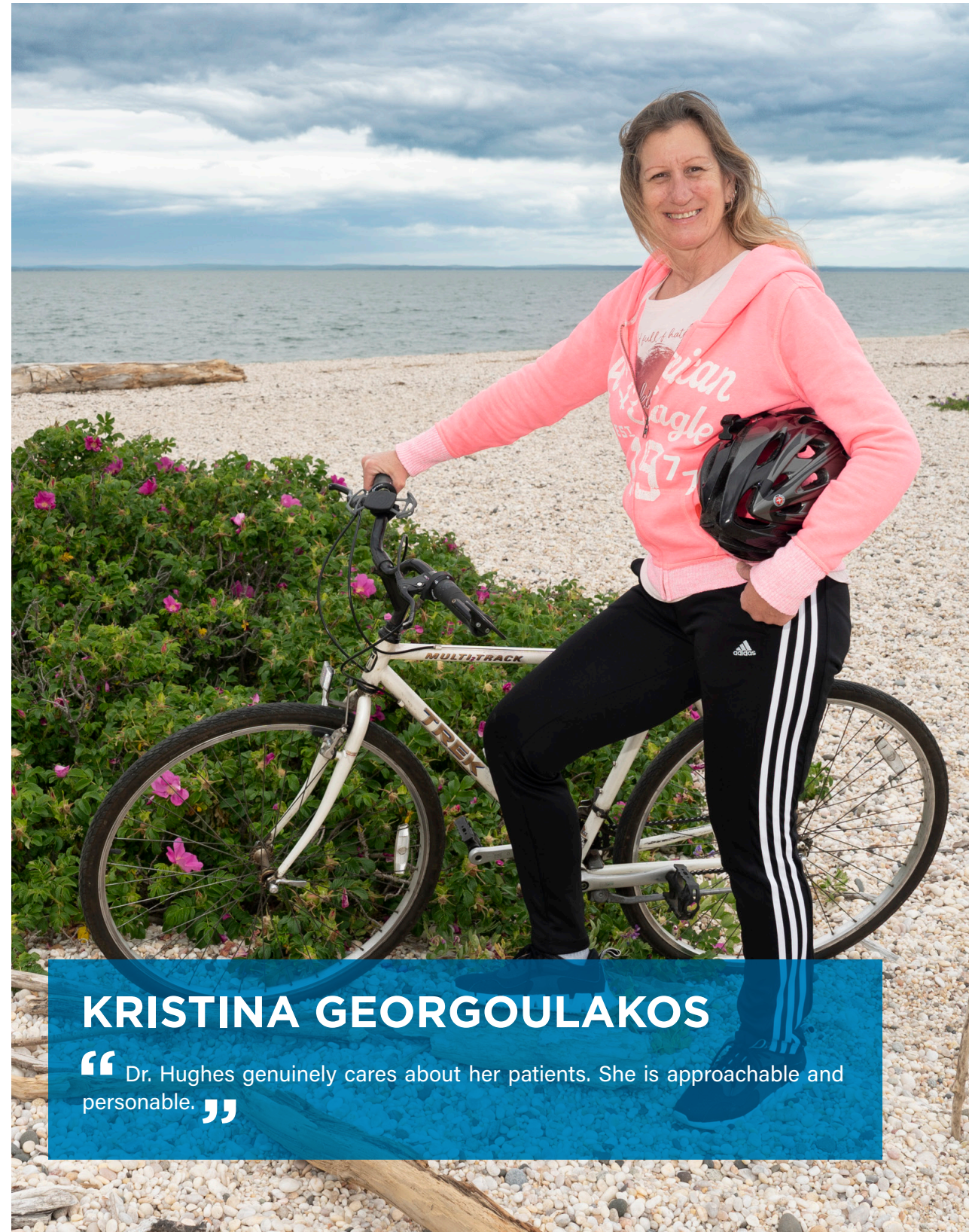

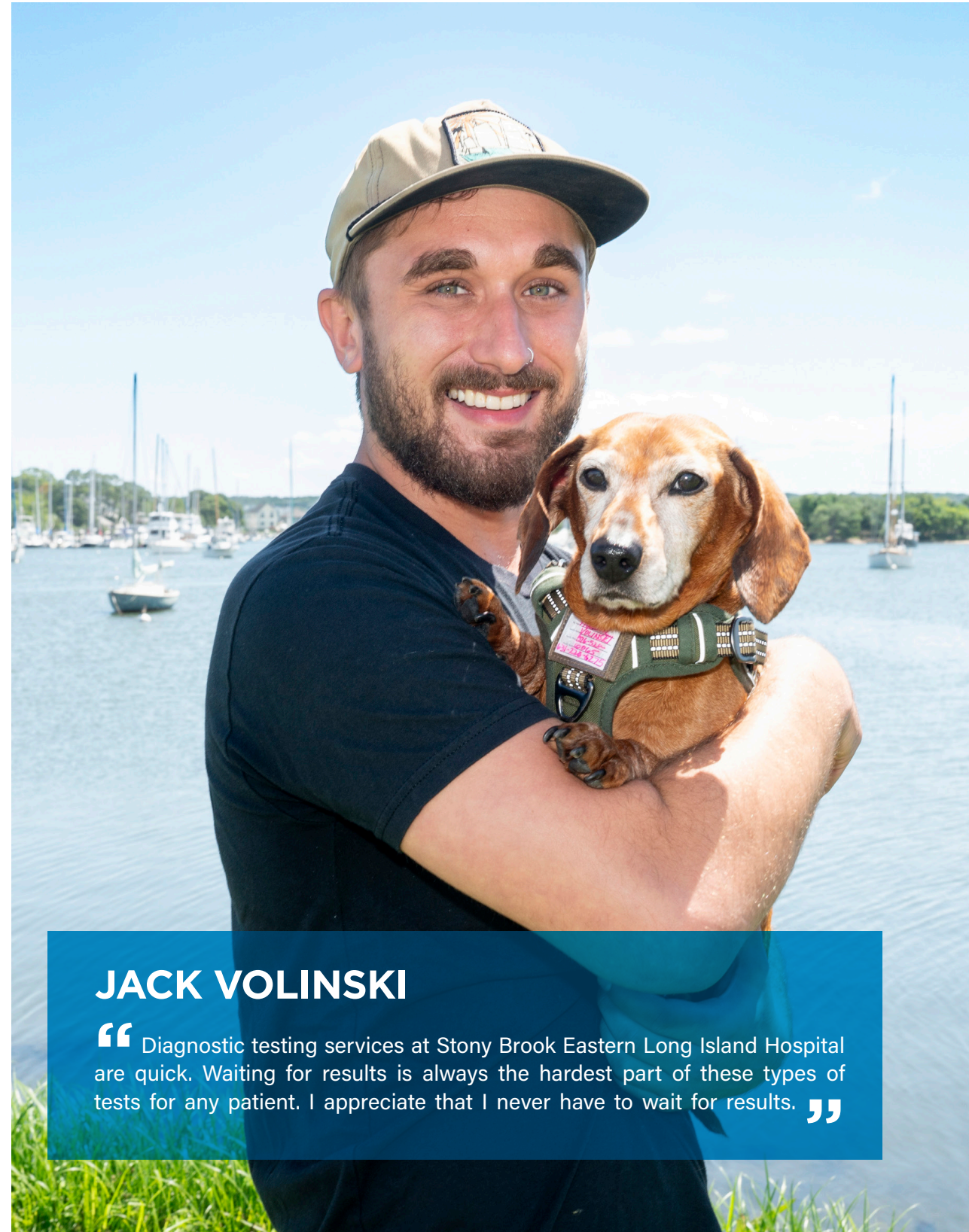

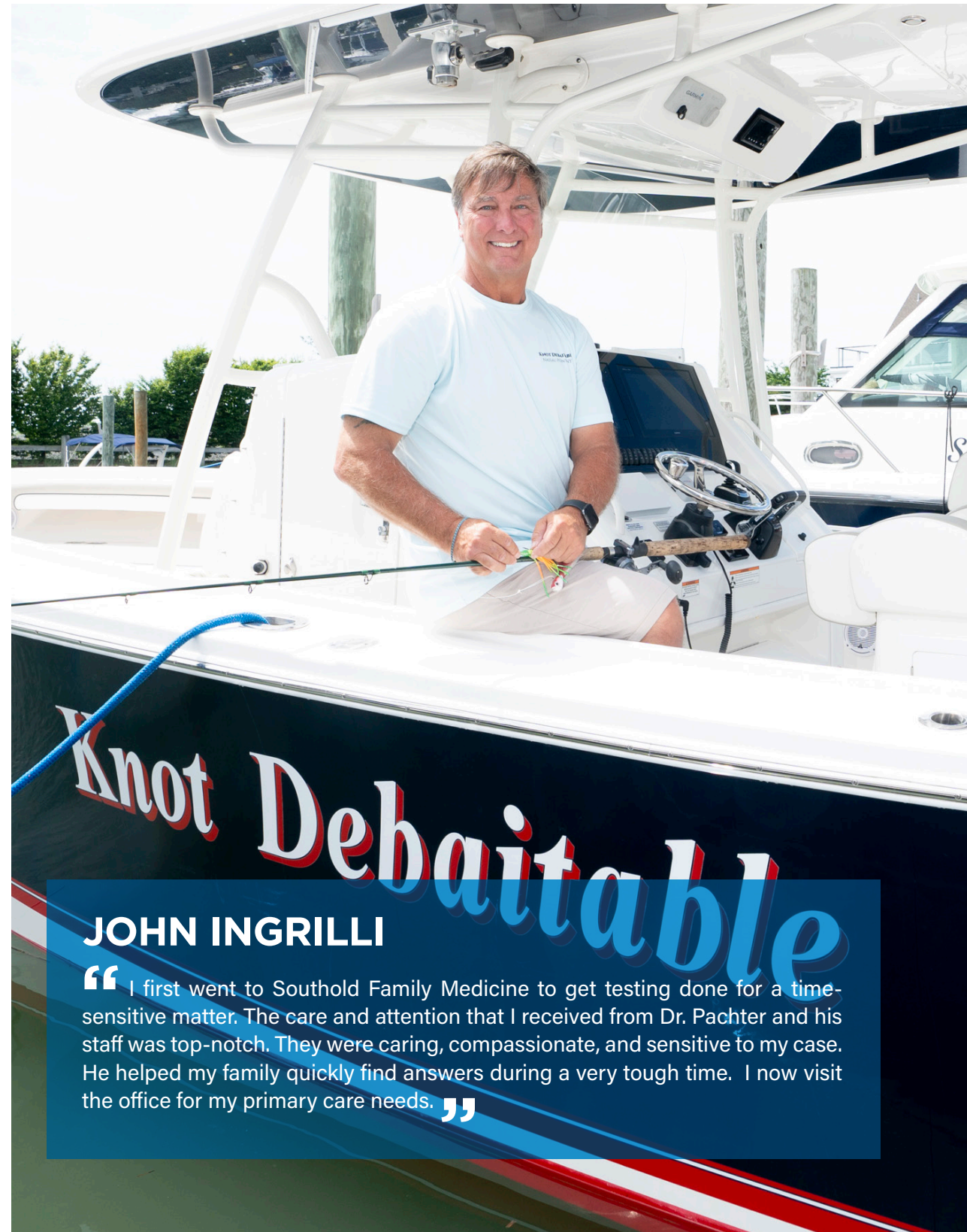
